Following documents are required at the time of interview:

- i) A copy of application submitted through EAS application system of Commonwealth Scholarship Commission. **Only those candidates having copy of the finally submitted EAS application will be allowed to appear before the Selection Committee for interview.**
- ii) A Ph.D. applicant is required to produce supporting statement of at least one of the potential supervisors of the candidates' chosen institutions/universities of the United Kingdom. No Ph.D. candidates would be interviewed without the supporting statement of the supervisor.
- iii) A detailed research proposed.
- iv) Original certificates, degrees/diplomas, proof of age (Matriculation/Higher Secondary Certificate), experience certificate(s), research or other paper(s) that has been published, as mentioned in the application submitted at the Ministry of Human Resource Development website <http://proposal.sakshat.ac.in/scholarship> . Please bring a copy of all these documents.
- v) If employed, the candidate is required to bring a 'No Objection Certificate' to the effect that he/she will be relieved by his/her employer in the event of his/her selection.
- vi) The candidates who have been awarded grades from their university/ institute are required to bring the conversion formula and the marks in the percentage form, duly certified by the concerned university/ institute.
- vii) Reference from three referees.
- viii) Three colour passport size photograph.
- ix) English version of those certificates/degree or any other documents which are not in English.



3. If the candidates fail to bring the requisite documents as stated above, he/she will not be interviewed.

4. Candidates should have adequate knowledge about India and the donor country. The candidate's personality, general awareness and knowledge of Indian History besides subject knowledge, will count towards his/her evaluation for final selection.

5. It must be clearly understood that the date and time of the interview will not be altered under any circumstances. You are, therefore, advised to take all precautions to arrive on time.

6. As per the requirement of the Commonwealth Scholarship Commission the nomination would be done Development Theme wise.


