**NOTIFICATION**

**Whereas**, 'Kalinga Institute of Industrial Technology (KIIT)', Bhubaneswar, Odisha was declared as deemed to be university under Section 3 of the University Grants Commission (UGC) Act, 1956 vide this Ministry's Notification No. F.9-49/2001-U.3 dated the 16<sup>th</sup> February, 2004 subject to a review after five years.

2. **And whereas**, as per the provisions of the Ministry's Notification dated 16.02.2004, UGC Expert Committee & AICTE Expert Committee visited the Institute in the year 2008 to review the functioning of the Kalinga Institute of Industrial Technology, Bhubaneswar, Odisha. The Expert Committee of AICTE pointed out that "the number of faculty with Ph.D qualifications in KIIT Deemed to be University, Bhubaneswar is less than 50%" which needed to be rectified by the Institute within a period of three months.

3. **And whereas**, the reports of the Committees were placed before the Commission in its 461<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 04.08.2009 in which following Resolution was passed:

*"The Commission considered and approved the report of the UGC Expert Committee constituted by the Chairman, UGC, AICTE Expert Committee and its advice on the review of the Deemed to be University status conferred on KIIT, Bhubaneswar, Orissa and to recommend to the Ministry of Human Resource Development for continuation of Deemed to be University status to the KIIT, Bhubaneswar, Orissa subject to review after five years. The Commission further decided that a copy of the Report may be sent to Deemed to be University with a direction to comply with deficiencies / suggestions and send a compliance Report to the Commission within a period of three months".*

4. **And further whereas**, the Central Government, on the advice of the UGC, accorded approval to continuation / extension of Deemed to be University status to 'Kalinga Institute of Industrial Technology (KIIT)' Bhubaneswar, Odisha for another period of five years i.e. from 16.02.2009 to 15.02.2014 in terms of this Ministry's Notification No. F.9-49/2001-U.3 dated the 16<sup>th</sup> February, 2004. It was also added that further extension of Deemed to be University status shall be done only after rectification of deficiencies as pointed out by the AICTE Expert Committee in the year 2008.

5. **And whereas**, an UGC Expert Committee visited KIIT Deemed University from 9-11<sup>th</sup> December, 2016 to review the functioning of Deemed to be University. The Commission in its 520<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 14<sup>th</sup> December, 2016 considered the report of UGC Expert Committee and resolved as under:

*“Considered and approved with the condition that all the deficiencies pointed out, if any, would be rectified and the suggestions given by the Expert Committee would be implemented within a period of 6 months and the compliance report would be submitted along with documentary proof to UGC”.*

6. **Now, therefore**, in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, the Central Government, on the advice of the UGC, hereby accord approval to continuation / extension of Deemed to be University status to ‘Kalinga Institute of Industrial Technology (KIIT)’ Bhubaneswar, Odisha for another period of five years w.e.f. 16.02.2014 subject to the conditions that all the suggestions / deficiencies pointed out by the UGC Expert Committee shall be rectified by the Institute. This approval is further subject to condition that the Institution shall amend its MoA / Rules as per the existing UGC Regulations.
