**Summary record of discussion of the Sixth Project Approval Board (PAB) Meeting of the Pandit Madan Mohan Malviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (PMMMNTT) held on 13<sup>th</sup> July, 2016**

The Sixth Project Approval Board (PAB) Meeting of the Pandit Madan Mohan Malviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (PMMMNTT) was held under the Chairmanship of Secretary (HE) MHRD on Wednesday, 13<sup>th</sup> July, 2016 at 10:30 am in the Conference Room No. 112-C Wing, Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi to consider various proposals received from institutions for the different components of the Scheme. Secretary (SEL), MHRD could not attend the meeting and was represented by Shri J. Alam, Joint Secretary (TE), MHRD. The list of participants is at **Annexure I**.

2. At the outset of the meeting, Joint Secretary (Policy) welcomed the PAB members and the participating representatives of various universities/institutes attending the meeting.
3. The minutes of the Fifth PAB meeting held on 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2016 were confirmed.
4. Thereafter, the Chair invited the proposing institutions to make a presentation on the proposals submitted. A total of 12 proposals from 11 institutions were being considered in this PAB meeting as shown at **Annexure II**.
